EmergyCare is hiring a full-time and part-time hourly non-exempt Wheelchair/ Medical Transporter(s). This position provides transportation for wheelchair, medical taxi, and stretcher transports taking patients to or from hospitals, nursing homes, doctor offices, and/or any other facility previously approved.

The Wheelchair Transporter works closely with the EMT to provide effective and efficient patient care per established protocols. The incumbent is accountable for the quality of emergency and non-emergency medical care delivered.

The WCT transporter performs all basic life support techniques, provides specified field treatment for medical emergencies, and transports patients to the appropriate medical facility by way of ambulance, wheelchair and/or medical van.

The Wheelchair Transporter must obtain his/her Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) Certification within two (2) years of hire and maintain it in the future.

The Wheelchair transporter must obtain Emergency Medical Services Vehicle Operator (EMSVO) credentials and maintain it in the future.

## Minimum Qualifications:

- Qualified candidates must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
- Must have a valid driver's license and excellent driving record.
- Successful applicant(s) must obtain Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) certification within two years of the date of hire and maintain current EMR certification thereafter.
- Candidates *must be at least 18 years of age or older d*ue to regulations set forth by the PA Public Utilities Commission (PUC).

## Preferred Qualifications:

Certification as a First Responder by the Commonwealth of PA, American Red Cross or the American Heart Association and a valid CPR card are preferred.

Qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or protected veteran status.
